Thursdays 3.30 – 4.30 Years 3-6

Drama Club is a fun, creative way for children to use their imaginations, develop empathy, express feelings and opinions, roleplay situations, make friends across year groups and improve confidence in a kind, safe and supportive environment.

Children practice thinking quickly and talking publicly while developing physical control and balance. They learn to look people in the eye; notice why people do what they do and consider how they would deal with situations like bullying or being scared. They learn about emotions and roleplay scenarios that they haven't yet encountered, which helps them to understand the world around them. We're living through a time where technology gives us shortcuts, yet Drama club helps students build the confidence and resilience to cultivate their social skills.

Drama Club has been running at the school for 22 years and is hugely popular. Club leader is Louise Parsons (stage name Louise Barrett) a professional actress with over 30 years acting experience in film, TV, theatre and audio.

Louise is a Voice Teacher for undergraduates and postgraduates and works as a voice and dialect coach in TV and theatre. She coaches voice in the corporate sector to help people to speak with more impact and presence. She is a dramaturg/performer for children's charity, 'Scene and Heard' in Tower Hamlets and runs Shakespeare workshops.
