Science	<u>Materials:</u> We will be identifying and sorting materials, learning the properties of different materials, discussing the uses of everyday materials and investigating how different materials change shape.	Science Museum
Geography	We will be learning about Mexico! We will locate and name the seven continents and five oceans, locate Mexico on a map, compare parts of Mexico with London and describe the physical and human features of places in Mexico. ICT	Create coding Children will create code to programme avatars to perform various activities and actions.	Code monkey is an excellent website to practice these skills.
PE	Ball skills Health and fitness	Talk to your child about the importance of eating healthily and what makes a balanced meal.
Art	<u>Textiles & collages</u> We will be looking at abstract art and artists such as Kandinsky and Mondrian.	
Music	Grandma Rap This unit explores beat and rhythm work using crotchets and quavers.
