
Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back Year 3. This half term we will be starting our new topic 'Climate and Biomes' and reading the text 'Varjak Paw'.

Most children should be joining their letters now, and all letters must be sitting on the line with ascender letters tall and descender letters coming under the line.</p>
